August 17, 2021

The PVAA meeting was called to order by Karen Simecka, president, @ 6:32 pm. Minutes: Judy Knoll

- Minutes from 5/10/21 were reviewed & approved.

Treasury Report: Diana Zimmerman

- Ending balance: \$1,617.70. That includes the Reading Program Fund: \$302.42 and \$1,315.28 in the general fund. The smaller balance since May can largely be attributed to the fees to the IRS and Secretary of State for paperwork filed for 501c3 tax exempt status at the end of May.
- Although we lost 10 members this year due to inactivity and not paying dues, our membership is basically staying steady with the addition of 7 new members this summer during our evaluations. All members are paid up on dues. Approved. Report filed with Diana.

- We need more evaluators for our PP evaluations in the future. Please think about becoming one - information on requirements are on the PP website.

Public Education Coordinator: Sharon Fricke

- Sharon talks about therapy dogs every day of her life. She is always open for interviews. She takes calls about what it takes to become a team. We have someone who can evaluate birds.

Social Media: Diana Zimmerman

- We've slowed down on having things to post. Remember we can only post faces if we have a signed release.
